



## Certificate of Conformity

As a manufacturer of adhesive tapes, tesa SE is a "downstream user" in the sense of the Regulation for the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH). You obtain from us only non-chemical articles (products). In principle, therefore, tesa SE is not subject to any obligation to register or to compile safety data sheets.

tesa SE hereby confirms that its adhesive tapes comply with the legal obligations regarding Article 33 of the European REACH Regulation 1907/2006 (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals), which came into force on 01.06.2007.

Based on the actual information by our suppliers (regarding Article 33) we can confirm that all tesa tapes do not contain any of the substances specified in the so-called ECHA "candidate list" SVHC-Substances of Very High Concern (REACH Article 59) with a concentration of more than 0.1 % by weight.

tesa SE and its suppliers will continuously review the actual ECHA "Candidate List" for additions and updates and act accordingly in compliance with REACH regulations. The actual candidate list is provided on the European Chemicals Agency website under the following address:

In the extremely unlikely situation that a tesa tape contains a substance what are listed in the ECHA "candidate list" SVHC (Article 59) with a weight of > 0.1%, we will promptly fulfill our obligation to provide information regarding Article 33.

In parallel, we will immediately set to work to replace these substances with an alternative.
